## **Sunshine Valley Landslide – Update**

On Thursday May 26, 2011 at approximately 4:30 p.m., a landslide occurred in Sunshine Valley, British Columbia impacting five property owners along Cedar Boulevard. Thankfully there were no major injuries and residents were able to get to safety. The RCMP evacuated residents immediately to ensure their safety.

Emergency Social Services (lodging, food and clothing) were immediately provided to residents affected by this landslide. As well, the landslide area was inspected by the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure given its proximity to Highway 3.

In response to this event, the Fraser Valley Regional District, in partnership with Emergency Management BC, has hired the engineering firm of Golder Associates to assess the affected area to identify the possible causes of the landslide. Golder Associates will provide a report with respect to their findings. The report will also provide recommendations to the specific property owners who have been impacted by this event. The Golder Associates' report will be posted to the home page of the FVRD website ([www.fvrd.bc.ca](http://www.fvrd.bc.ca)) as soon as it is received by the FVRD.

Electoral Area Director Dennis Adamson, the elected official representing Sunshine Valley, extends his sincere appreciation for a job well done to the FVRD Staff, RCMP, ESS, MoTI, Emergency Management BC and all those who provided assistance and support to the residents impacted by this event.
