**Bylaw No. 0996, 2010**

**A Bylaw to Establish an Advisory Planning Commission  
for Deroche, Electoral Area "G"**

---

WHEREAS the Regional Board of the Fraser Valley Regional District has deemed it advisable to establish an Advisory Planning Commission for Deroche, Electoral Area "G" pursuant to Section 898 of the Local Government Act;

THEREFORE the Board of Directors of the Fraser Valley Regional District in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

**A. ESTABLISHMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF THE COMMISSION**

1. The Regional Board hereby establishes an Advisory Planning Commission for Deroche, Electoral Area "G".
2. The Board shall forthwith appoint members of the Advisory Planning Commission to make recommendations and advise the Board on matters respecting the preparation of a Local Area Plan for Deroche, Electoral Area "G".
3. The Advisory Planning Commission shall consist of not more than seven (7) members, and at least 2/3 of the members must be residents of Electoral Area "G".
4. The Commission shall elect one of its members as Chairman and another as Vice-Chairman to act in the absence of the Chairman.
5. In the event of the resignation of a member of the Commission, the Regional Board may appoint a successor to serve the balance of the term of appointment.
6. A member of the Regional District staff shall act as Secretary to the Commission.

**B. REFERRALS TO THE COMMISSION**

7. The Regional Board, the Electoral Area Services Committee or the Director for the Board for Electoral Area "G" may refer matters respecting the preparation of a local area plan enacted under Part 26 of the Local Government Act, or other related matters pursuant to part 26 of the Local Government Act associated to the local area plan, to the Advisory Planning Commission in order that it may advise the Board on those matters.


**C. COMMISSION PROCEDURES**


8. A quorum is a majority of the members of the Commission.

- 9. A decision of the Commission shall be made by consensus. In the event that consensus can not be reached, a decision may be made by a majority of the members present at a meeting.
- 10. The Chairman or any two members may call a meeting of the Commission upon giving at least four days' notice to each member.
- 11. Where any member of the Advisory Planning Commission or his family or his employer or his business associates has any conflict of interest with any matter being considered by the Commission, that member shall declare the conflict and shall not participate in the consideration of that matter.
- 12. Members of the Advisory Planning Commission shall serve without remuneration but shall be entitled to reimbursement for those expenditures incurred in the performance of their duties.
- 13. The Secretary of the Advisory Planning Commission shall keep necessary records of meetings and of expenses, and perform such other secretarial duties as may be from time to time required by the Commission.
- 14. A copy of the minutes and of all reports of the Advisory Planning Commission shall be sent to the Electoral Area Services Committee of the Regional Board.
- 15. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "Advisory Planning Commission for Deroche Bylaw No. 0996, 2010.


