

Island 22 Boat Launch Information Sheet

Boat launch users, please be aware that:

- Vehicles not launching boats **must** park in designated parking areas labeled as 'Day Use Parking' on the map displayed on the reverse of this paper.
- To maximize boat launch capacity, please park trucks and trailers in a straight and orderly fashion.
- To avoid injuring people on shore with your wake, do not throttle your craft until well beyond the boat launch.
- Excessive speed and/or horseplay with your boat is not permitted near the boat launch.
- When loading your boat on the trailer, do not use your engine as it creates an underwater gravel berm that will make launching difficult later in the year. Use your winch to fully load your boat.
- When launching your boat, do not spend excessive time loading gear, putting on waders or visiting with others; get your truck and boat out of the way as quickly as possible to make room for others to launch.
- When removing your boat from the water, drive your loaded boat to an out of the way location before unloading gear, changing clothing and finalizing the boat's safety straps.
- Consumption of alcohol is not permitted in the park.
- Do not leave fish entrails in the garbage cans; dispose of them in a swift flowing section of the river.
- Children must be closely supervised at all times.
- Dogs **must** be on-leash at all times unless in the off-leash area.
- People who observe rule violations or unsafe boating practices can contact the park contractor or Regional Park staff to report the occurrence.

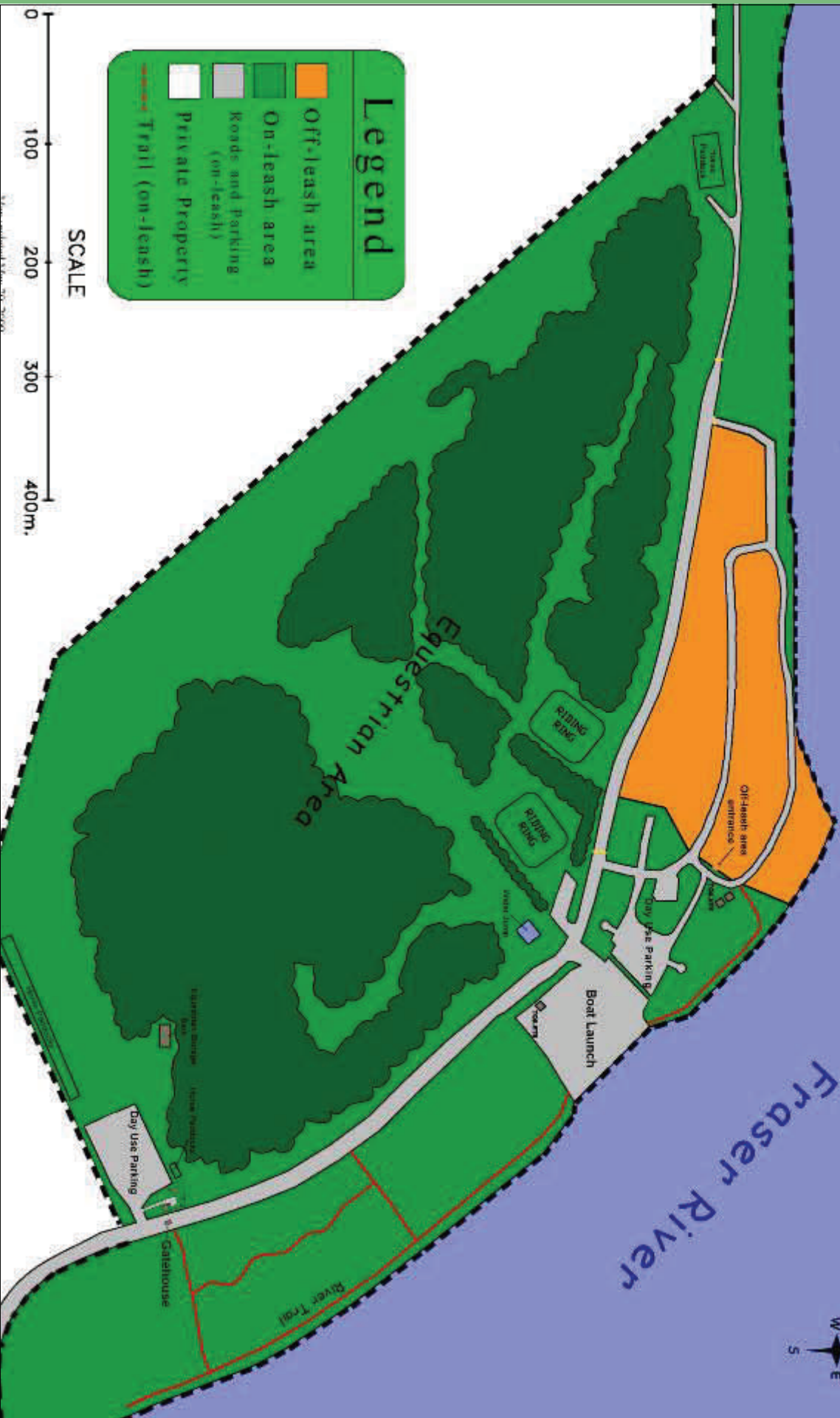

Island 22 Regional Park

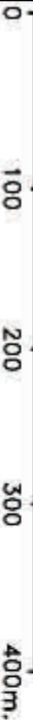
Fraser River
