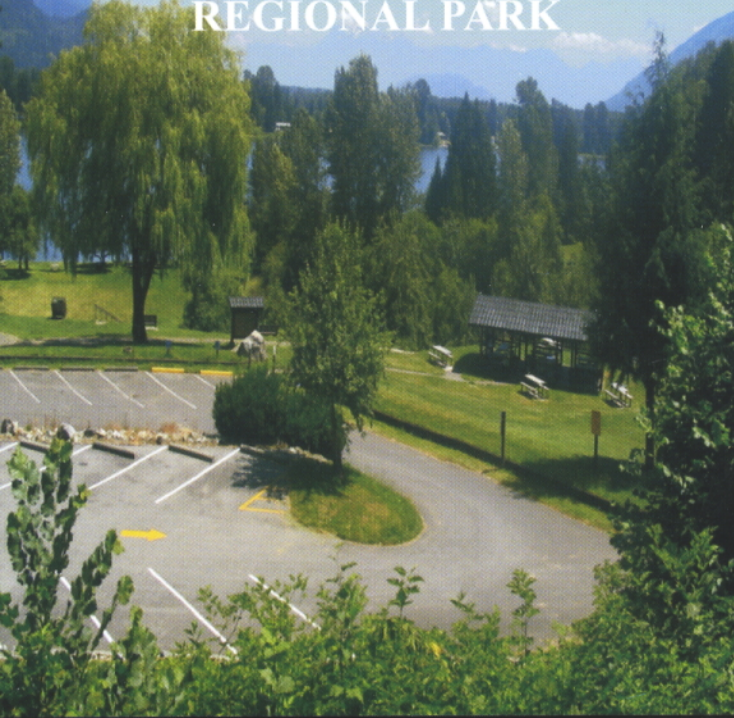

This 10 hectare regional park has become a a major public park on Hatzic lake. Development has been aimed at retaining much of the wildlife habitat, while providing facilities for the public. The eastern exposure of the park offers a magnificent view across Hatzic Lake and up the Fraser Valley to Mount Cheam.

This park is popular for large picnics and organized gatherings, nature viewing, walking trails, and beach activities. A small run of Chum salmon, which arrive in early November, spawn in Draper Creek that runs through the park. The park has several facilities incl. two toilets, clean drinking water, a sheltered cookhouse, and 12 picnic tables. Reservations can be made by calling (604) 820-5140.



LOCATION:

From Lougheed Hwy east of Mission turn left on Dewdney Trunk Rd, right on McEwen Ave, then left onto Edwards St. At the bottom of the hill turn left on Edwards St. East.

PARK REGULATIONS

SEASONAL Apr.1 to Oct.1 - 10am to 7pm.

SWIMMING: Is permitted in the designated swimming area, but there are **no lifeguards** on duty.
